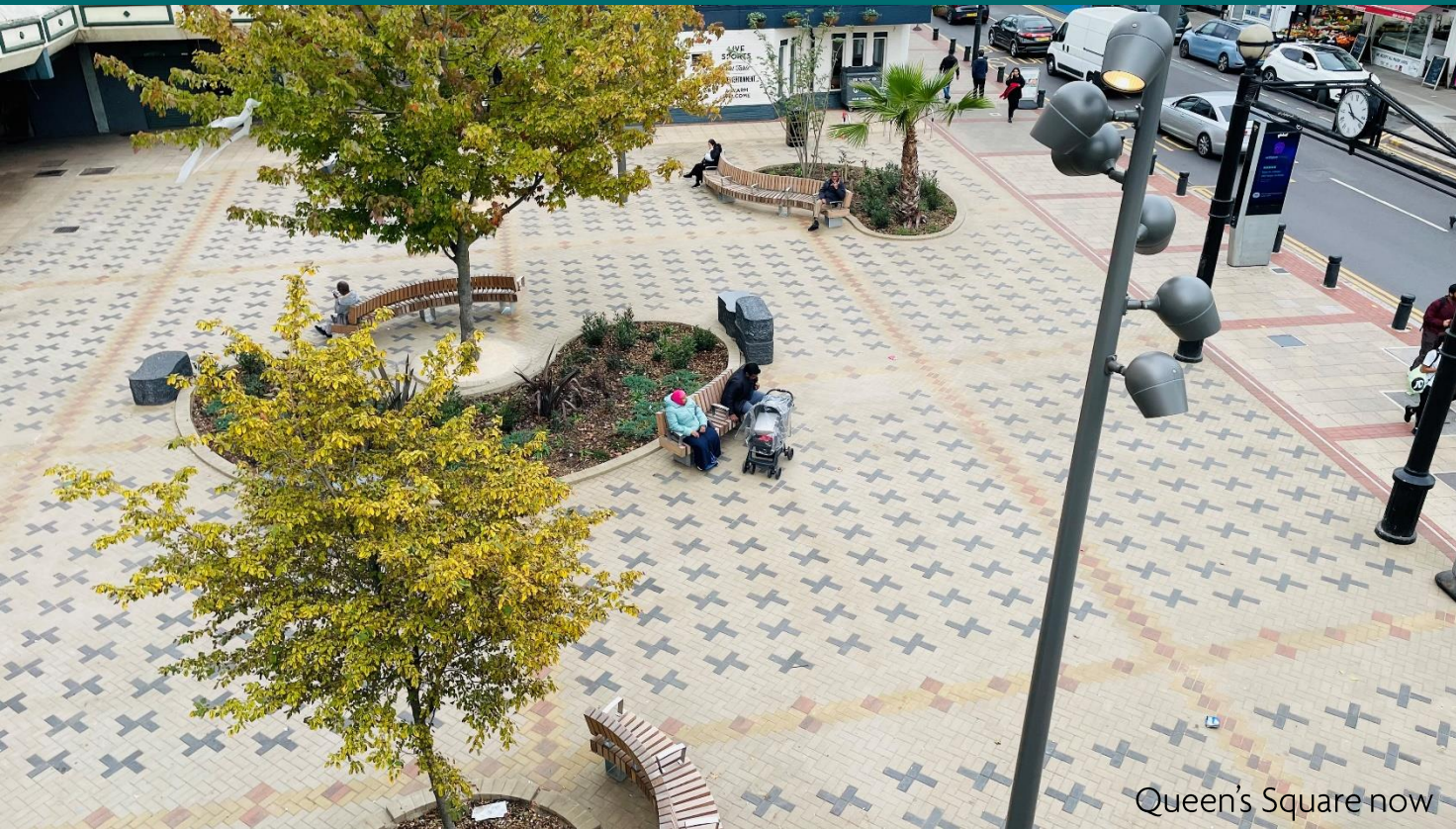


We delivered for you an improved Queen's Square.

We co-designed this together.

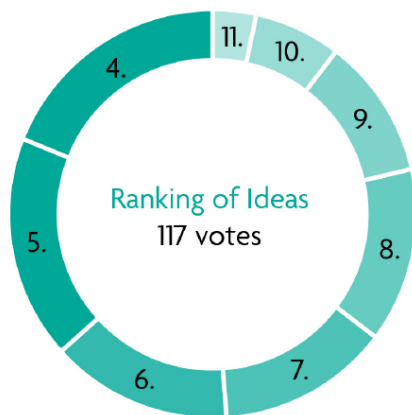
Through the co-design and engagement activities between 2020 and 2022, you told us what is really important to you for now and for the future of Queen's Square.

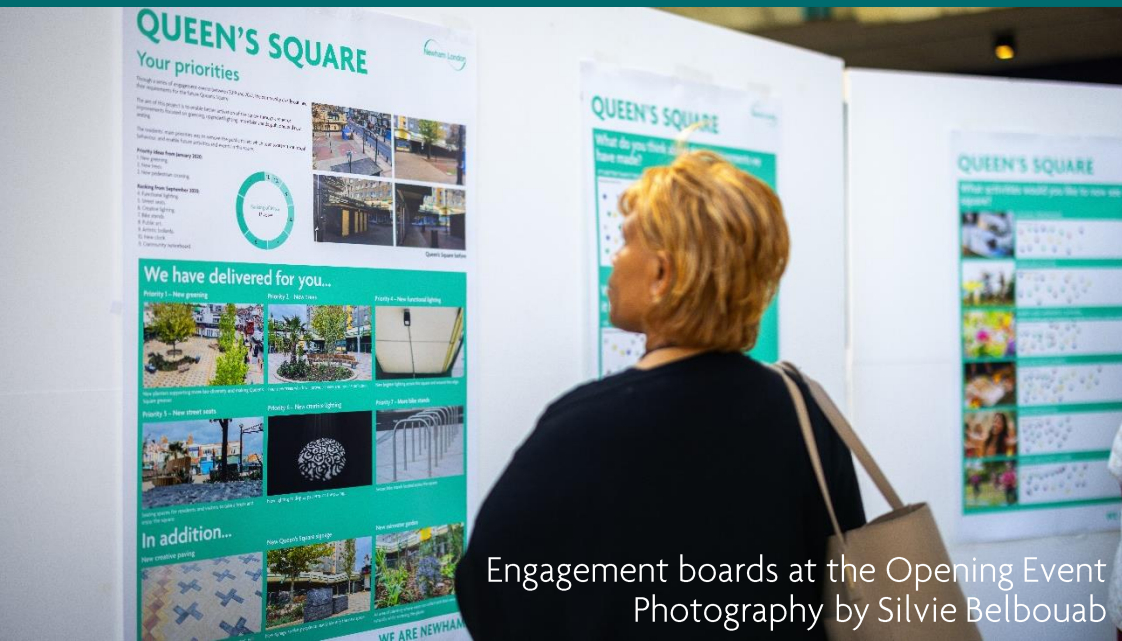
