## Newham high streets

Since September 2020, the Council has been engaging with local residents to gather ideas about what they would like to see in their high streets. We have now gathered and organised all your suggestions from the online survey, meetings, emails and phone calls, and taken into consideration your feedback from the Citizens Assemblies and Shape Newham engagement, to create a list of your project ideas for Manor Park's local centre of Station Road.

For Station Road and its adjacent area, the most important future aspirations related to the following key themes: **Environment & Climate**, **Health & Wellbeing**, and **Public Realm & Placemaking**. You highlighted the need to manage traffic better, enhance the public realm and make it more pedestrian-friendly, improve levels of cleanliness, and have a diversified offer.

We have now gathered and organised all your suggestions to create a list of your project ideas that address the issues above and will form part of the strategic delivery plan for Manor Park's high street of Station Road.
