Contractor and project update

Following our Phase One masterplan planning application in March 2023, we are awaiting to hear a decision in September. Meanwhile, procurement is happening to select a contractor who will work with us to develop the detailed designs for the buildings at 64-80 Coolfin Road and 35-75 Ethel Road. Once these designs have been completed we will need to submit these to planning to get approval to start work on those buildings, hopefully starting on site by the summer of 2024. We will arrange a “meet the contractor” event at the regeneration hub once appointed.

Meanwhile Space update

Our search for a partner to refresh the Custom House Regeneration Hub and make it into a more active community hub has begun. Alongside this, we will also instruct the partners to look at options for bringing the vacant land behind Normandy (where May Wynne House used to be) into use until permanent new buildings are constructed there. Residents will be able to share their views on these plans when we have appointed a partner.

You will have seen work progressing to refurbish the retail spaces on Normandy Terrace. We received a large number of applications for our previously advertised retail opportunity. Assessments are underway to identify the best proposal. As soon as the successful applicant is confirmed we will work with them to get the shop up and running and let the local community what is coming.

Grants up to £20,000 now open

Custom House residents who live, work or learn in Newham can now apply for a grant of up to £5,000, and Voluntary, community and faith sector (VCFS) groups can apply for a grant of up to £20,000, as part of the 2023-25 People Powered Places programme.

Grants are for projects based in one of Newham's 8 Community Neighbourhoods, that meet the top 3 priorities as voted for by residents. [Applications](#) are open until Thursday 3 September 2023.
